Introduction

The position of the Lucan Sarsfields Director of (code) is a key position in our Club. The Director of (code) must have an excellent knowledge of (code) within the club and an appreciation for best practice in a high performance sporting organisation. The role will be fully supported by the Club Executive.

Role

The Director will implement, develop and monitor the structure within the (code) Section from Academy to Adult. This involves the identification and selection of Club Members for key leadership positions, and definition of their role in promoting (code) within the Club.

Where the players numbers necessitate it, a juvenile director may be appointed to focus on the juvenile component of the role (Academy to Under 16). In this case, the juvenile director should work closely with the Director of code to ensure a seamless experience for players and management teams.

Functions

- Appoint the juvenile and adult management teams in collaboration with the code committee
- Succession planning for management of teams
- Develop and agree performance-based goals with management teams
- Conduct end of year reviews (at a minimum) with each management team
- Co-ordination and planning of panels and players, including management of player regrading
- Transition of players from juvenile level to adult
- Player retention at all age groups

Functions (contd.)

- Establish processes to ensure we are leveraging the involvement of both primary and secondary schools in the area in the development of the code.
- Ensure all mentors and volunteers have completed the necessary mandatory requirements – vetting, child protection, minimum coaching course
- Facilitate and support the rollout of the club coaching practice
- Interface between Club Executive and managers
- Manage the process to get adult players and ex-players back into the area of coaching juveniles and overseeing structures.
- Develop a co-ordinated approach to manage player availability, with particular attention to dual players and avoidance of player overload
- Foster a positive Culture within the section that instils a sense of belonging and value to the club

Code Committee

1. This group will be responsible for the management of all (code) activities in the club, from Academy to Adult.
2. It will be responsible for the appointment of all (code) coaches and mentors, which will then be ratified by the Executive
3. Responsible for the promotion of (code) by liaising with the Club PRO.
4. Liaise with local school representatives on issues relating to (code).
5. Liaise with adult and juvenile games committees to ensure that facilities required for (code) are provided for.
6. Provide a monthly summary of (code) activity to the Executive Committee.
7. All directors to meet quarterly with club chairperson and secretary, adult games chairperson and secretary
8. The code committee membership is decided by the Director of Code, with a minimum of 5 members including the director of code.
9. A review to be conducted every 2 years by the club chairperson with each Code Director
